

CORNEAL TRANSPLANT

Post-Operative Instructions

Do's:

- Do take your prescribed antibiotic pills.
- Do take Tylenol as needed for pain.
- Do call the doctor if you experience pain that is not controlled with Tylenol.
- Do call the doctor with any questions or concerns you may have regarding your surgery.
- Do leave the patch and shield on your eye until you see the doctor the morning after your surgery.

Don'ts:

- Don't do any heavy lifting, bending over, or heavy exercise
- Don't remove the patch that has been placed on your eye

Other Instructions:

Eye drop regimen to be started <u>after</u> seeing your surgeon on the first post-operative day.

- 1. Prednisolone Acetate 1% Use one drop every two hours while awake in the eye that underwent surgery. Make sure to shake the bottle before using!
- 2. Zymaxid/Vigamox/gatifloxacin- Use one drop four times a day in the eye that underwent surgery.
- 3. Ciprofloxacin tablets (orally ingested antibiotic)- Take one 500 milligram tablet in the morning and one 500 milligram tablet in the evening for a full 7 days.
- 4. Make sure to wear your plastic eye-shield whenever you sleep.
